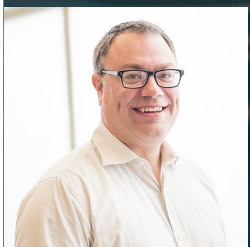
FAMILY CAMP SPEAKERS 2021

–June 27–July 2

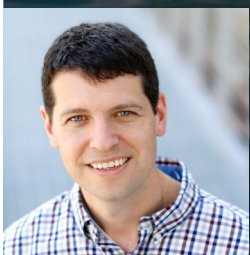

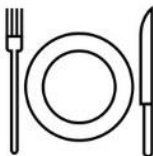
Please call the camp at 712-337-3306 to reserve your housing. Housing cost is listed here only as a reference.
